Established Date:

1 August 2007

Objective:

The Objective of the Membership Committee shall be to actively promote membership in the Society of American Foresters among all professional foresters within the geographical area of the Division.

Organization:

The Membership Committee shall consist of a Chair who is the Division Chair-elect, and one member from each Chapter. Members shall serve one-year terms.

Activities:

1. Coordinate recruitment and retention activities on behalf of the Division;
2. Welcome new members via letter, e-mail, or phone, and invite them to upcoming meetings or functions;
3. Build connections with student chapters and faculty representatives to promote membership;
4. Provide articles/information to the Southeastern Society newsletter regarding meetings, membership updates, and membership campaigns;
5. Act as host to potential new members at Division and Chapter functions;
6. Remind members to renew membership;
7. Personally contact delinquent members to encourage reinstatement;
8. Plan and carry out local membership drives in coordination with national membership drives;
9. Promote membership at opportunities other than SAF meetings, e.g., contacts with other professional societies; and
10. Provide membership reports to the Division Executive Committee and the SESAF business office.
